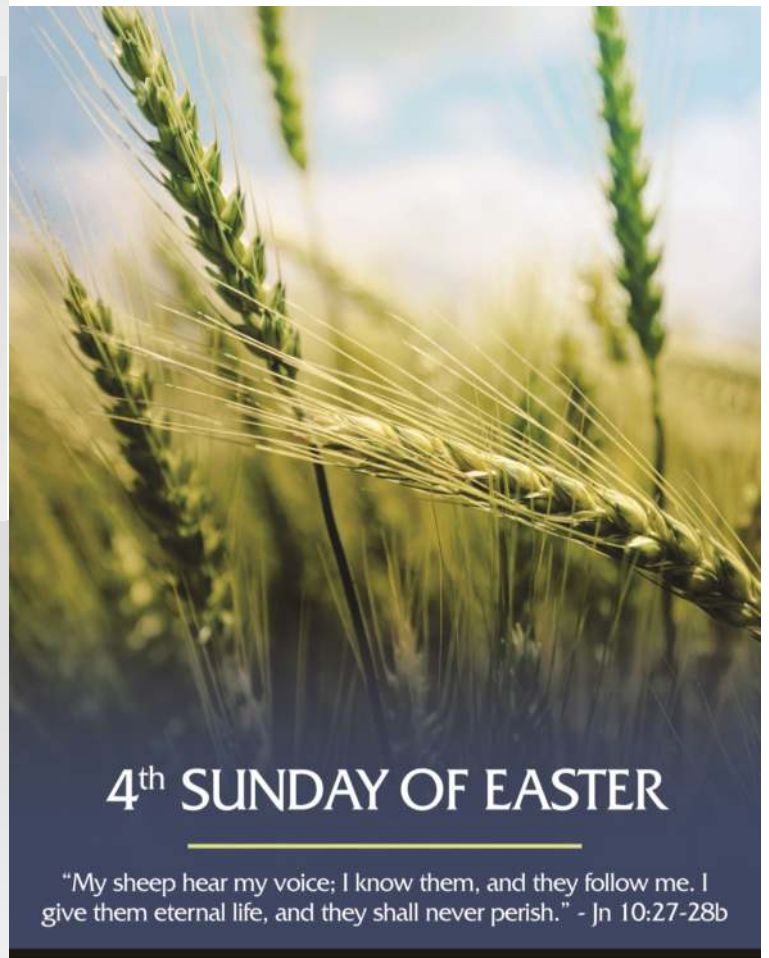

From Father Mike Tix . . .

On this weekend, we recognize and celebrate our Moms! It's easy for us in our busy lives, to take for granted all that a Mom does for her children and family. Today is a time to remember the life and love that a Mom shares in the many ways of our daily life. I hope that you will take the time today to thank your Mom, and if your Mom is deceased, to somehow honor her memory. Thanks to all of the Moms in our community, for all that you selflessly do in ways that echo Mary the Mother of God and her "Yes!" to sharing God's love with our world.

Last weekend I announced that Archbishop Hebda has appointed me as Parochial Administrator of St. Mary, St. Mathias, and St. John the Baptist. In order to balance the parish needs with my assignment as Episcopal Vicar for Clergy and Parish Services in the Archdiocese, I've needed to make some changes in the daily Mass schedule to accommodate my Archdiocesan schedule to work for everyone involved. Please note in today's bulletin that at least for the time being that there will be a 7:30 am Mass on Tuesday at St. Mathias, 9:00 am Mass on Wednesday at St. John the Baptist (until the school year ends and then 7:30 am), and 7:30 am Mass on Friday at St. Mary. I hope this won't be too much of an inconvenience to anyone.

Also, I want to again congratulate all of those who received their First Communion last weekend. It was not only a special day for our young people and their families, but also all of our parishes. First Communion invites us all to recall the gift of the Eucharist we receive, but also its invitation to go out to be the Body and Blood of Christ that we receive for our others.
