From Father Mike Tix

This past Monday I attended the St. John's School Spring Concert. It was fun to see people from St. Mary, St. Mathias, and St. John's, some were parents, others grandparents, along with friends and neighbors gathered to support the students as they shared their gift of music. The students at the concert did an amazing job with their singing, and I was left sitting in the pew listening to them, and thinking that God had to be looking down on them with a smile.

The occasion also left me with another thought as I watched the students of different ages, from different families and parishes, all gathered together for the one performance. It was a reminder to me of what can happen when people work together. At the concert, as the students were working together, the result was a great concert that echoed to heaven. The example provides a good example for us as adults about what's possible when we all work together. Like the kids who shared a great concert, as adults we have the opportunity to also create something beautiful for God. Consider the three parishes – St. Mary, St. Mathias, and St. John's – and how these buildings were built more than a hundred years ago. They are the result of people gathered in faith, trusting in God, and working together.

We have that same opportunity today. By our working together, great things are possible for each of the three parishes that build upon a strong past. At the same time, there are things that can limit and hinder the possibility for good. Pope Francis talks about rumors and gossips as things that can bring harm to individuals, as well as the efforts of the church in sharing a message of God's love for our times. He says rumors and gossip are sinful occasions to be avoided because they cause divisions as opposed to our call to build up the Body of Christ among us with values like truth, honesty, and respect. In these Easter days as we reflect on the presence of the Risen Jesus among us, may we learn from the students a lesson about how we are each called to work together in positive ways that offer a great song of praise and result in God smiling down upon us and our work as church.

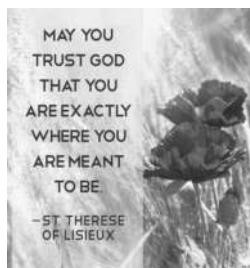
